HIT	30	60	Advanced approach. Plus bat speed natural feel for the barrel in any quadrant of the zone. Drives the ball to all fields consistently, Line-Line, middle of the field approach. Smooth compact swing, consistently short and inside to the ball, with a consistent bat path. Gets on top of High Fastballs 95+ MPH. Even when fooled, he does a great job of keeping his hands and weight back to drive the ball to RF with consistent hard contact. Quick hands. Not afraid to hit with 2 strikes. Not much Swing and Miss. Jeter-Esque bat control and approach.	Athletic build. Sloped Shoulders. Proportional legs to body size. With projection remaining in the frame. Room to add 10-20 lbs, with strength. No glasses. Similar body to Xander Bogaerts of the Red Sox. Prototypical Shortstop build.
RAW POWER	50	60	The ball gets a bit more carry off the bat than you would expect. Not looking to sell out for Power, bat path is built to find hard Line drives. Short to the ball with plus extension. Above-Average Hip Separation.	<b>STANCE:</b> Athletic stance. Starts open with a quick leg kick. Foot down early. Slightly bent knees. Weight starts on the front leg and shifts back. High back elbow. The head stays quiet during the swing.
GAME POWER	30	50	Showing mostly Pull Power to the pull side for now, but has the look of being able to hit the ball out to all fields in the near future. Gets extension and loft in his swing and uses his lower half well. As the body matures there hope for him to tap into the full 55 Power in Game with how easy the ball jumps off the bat.	<b>STRENGTHS:</b> Approach at the plate is beyond his years. Using the entire field with such ease and consistently finding barrels. Makes in-game adjustments quickly. Plus Bat Speed with a Line-Line approach. Will not strike out much, while working walks at a Plus rate. Defensively, makes all the plays and then some at a premium position. Accurate Arm and good footwork. The game comes naturally to him in all aspects.
PLATE DISC	35	60	Patient approach. Understands the pitcher's plan of attack, adjusts well. Lays off tough pitches in the shadow area with 2 strikes. Rarely will expand the strike zone, but will occasionally chase up. Picks up the ball early. Tracks pitches early out of the hand. Project for 12-15% BB Rates.	<b>WEAKNESSES:</b> Older for the HS Class (18.9) on Draft Day. But advanced with that age. At times he can get too comfortable looking for pitches out over the plate and can lead to some fastballs jamming him on the inner-half. Gets a bit too much weight on the front side, leaving some power behind in the process.
FIELD	50	60	Clean actions, footwork. Under control, quick, balanced, with soft hands. Quick 1st step. Knows when to take the extra hops away. Light on his feet taking efficient angles to balls up the middle. Slow rollers, gets his body around the ball in a strong position to make a throw.	
ARM	55	60	85 MPH from INF in workouts. Over the top with minimal tail. Good accuracy. Quick transfer. Shows multiple arm angles with ease and makes throws from the hole and on the move consistently on target.	
RUN	70	60	60 Yard: 6.45 sec – 10 Yard Split: 1.68 sec – HM → 1st: 4.15 sec – SB 2nd: 3.32 sec – HM → 3rd: 10.97 sec. Aggressive base runner 1st to 3rd, and 2nd to HM. 10-15 SB potential.	

**REPORT SUMMATION:** Jordan Lawlar has 1.1 talent and a very likely Top 5 Pick in the 2021 Draft. The game comes easy to Lawlar. Very natural actions and consistent performances, and checks virtually every box early in the process. The only question is the Age as an HS Senior (18.9). Looks comfortable vs any level of competition. Whether it be in the box, defensively, or on the basepaths, the game comes so easy and naturally to Lawlar. As he shows the rare ability to slow the game down at a young age. Prototypical 2 hole hitter, doing everything so well while having Plus-Plus bat control and a run producer. An impact player on a Championship Caliber team on both sides of the ball.
